**Adrián Lajous** is Chairman of the Oxford Institute for Energy Studies, President of Petrométrica, SC and non-Executive Director of Schlumberger, Ternium, Trinity Industries and Grupo Petroquímico Beta. He is senior energy advisor to McKinsey & Company. He has held fellowships at the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University and at the Kellogg Institute at the University of Notre Dame.

In 1994 Adrián Lajous was appointed Director General of Pemex (CEO) and Chairman of the Boards of the Pemex group of operating companies. He stepped down from this position in December 1999 after 29 years in public service.
